


*David Hunter passed away at his home in Surrey BC, on October 6, 2021 at the age of 76. He was predeceased by his niece Diane, in 1972; his mother Phyllis Hunter, in 1988; his father Bert Hunter, in 1998; and his stepmother, Phyllis Hunter #2, in 2016. David enjoyed a forty year career with Air Canada, first in reservations, then with Aeroplan, and retired in 2006. David and Joy enjoyed many memorable vacations and cruises together. He followed his retirement by keeping busy with a job of a different pace - stocking shelves at the Langley Walmart, where he worked until 2013. The best thing he did in life was to work for God. The retirement benefits are great! In 1962, at the age of 17, David made his choice to serve God alongside his parents, and kept strong in his faith for the rest of his days.*
